

Bath County parents and community members,

During the October 2, 2020 Bath County Board of Education meeting, the board voted to continue **100% virtual online learning until Sunday, October 18th, 2020.**

On **October 19, 2020** students will move to a **hybrid instructional schedule**. During a hybrid schedule, students are assigned to one of three groups (BCS North, BCS South, and 100% Online). Those assigned to **BCS North will attend in-person classes on Monday and Tuesday**. Those assigned to **BCS South will attend in-person classes on Thursday and Friday**. **Those students who selected 100% online during the registration process will remain online. All students will learn online every Wednesday** and the buildings will be thoroughly sanitized. This instructional schedule will continue through the end of the semester, December 18, 2020. The Bath County Board of Education will review data at the November meeting to plan the instructional schedule for the 2nd semester.

Our schools will communicate with you to inform you which group your child(ren) are in. You can also see this information in your student's Infinite Campus account or in your parent Infinite Campus account.

According to the group you are assigned, this is what the **hybrid schedule** will look like for your child:

BCS North (Monday and Tuesday)

Meal deliveries will continue as normal until the hybrid schedule begins. **Starting October 19, 2020 meal deliveries will be on Mondays and Wednesdays only** (not Friday).

This decision is pending that Bath County's COVID-19 numbers do not exceed the unhealthy numbers, according to a chart given to us by the Department of Kentucky Public Health. Should this happen, you will receive additional information about any changes to our schedule.
